Approve to proposal and to resolve that:-

Subject to consultation -

A stand for two hackney carriages be appointed on the south side of Between Towns Road. Oxford from a point 10.9 metres to the south of the east corner of 51 Between Towns Road, westwards for a distance of twelve metres.

**Background** 

1. Oxfordshire County Council have a made a number of changes to the

location of the bus stops in Between Towns Road to provide a bus turning

facility and as part of this exercise have made provision for a hackney

carriage rank. A plan is shown at Appendix 1

2. The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 empowers a

district council to appoint stands for hackney carriages for the whole or

part of the day in any highway in the district which is maintainable at public

expense.

Consultation

3. Before appointing any rank for hackney carriages, a district council shall

give notice to the Chief Officer of police for the area, seek consent from

the highway authority if the area is on the highway and shall also give the

public notice of the proposal by advertisement in at least one local

newspaper circulating in the district and shall take into consideration any

objections or representations in respect of such proposal.

4. Thames Valley Police have been consulted and have no objections.

5. Oxfordshire County Council is carrying out the scheme and has no

objections to the appointment of the rank.

6. Comments have been received from the taxi trade and are shown at

7. The appointment of this rank was an attempt by Oxfordshire County

Council to deal with the problem of private hire vehicles parking on the bus

stop. Since private hire vehicle will not be able to use the rank it will do

nothing to solve their stopping problem but may provide the opportunity for passengers to use a hackney carriage.

- 8. The lining for the rank is already in place, having been put down by the County Council when the lining for the bus scheme was put in, but is not yet signed.
- 9. Should the Committee decide that they wish to approve the new stand then a notice will be placed in a local newspaper inviting any further objections. Should there be objections raised following this publication of this notice then it may be necessary to return the matter to this Committee.



### Hackney Carriage Rank - Between Towns Road

As you will probably have noticed, the County Council have made alterations to the bus stops in Between Towns Road to facilitate a bus turning circle. They have incorporated a new hackney carriage rank in this plan and as a cost saving measure have in fact put down the basic road markings for this rank when doing the re-lining for the bus stops.

There is no proposal to make any changes to the existing rank in Barns Road but his office will obviously look to see what use each of the ranks gets.

The rank new will need formal approval by the City Council who have the responsibility for the appointment of ranks and in connection with this I am writing to ask interested parties if they have any comment to make about this new rank.

Should you have any comments, this office would be pleased to receive them within the next 14 days.

Hackney carriage rank

This new proposal will make life very difficult for the private hire trade, and our customers. A large amount of customers requiring taxis order there car to pick up from this proposed designated space it will mean frequently asking customers to move along the road as it will be unlawful for private hire vehicles to enter these spaces. Evidence of this effect can already be seen from the Hackney Rank on Barns Road. Due to there being a Taxi rank and Bus stop there is no room for any other vehicles to use pick up or drop off points. A typical example of this is a mother with children and shopping orders a taxi from "the Old Cowley Centre Post Office" when the driver arrives he is unable to use the pick up point so has to instruct his customers to either walk round the back cross the road or move down the street, which then can cause problems as many members of the public don't realise the difference between a private hire vehicle and a Hackney vehicle

which causes the impression that drivers are being difficult. Further more we feel that this first problem needs to be resolved before any further propositions take place and that the proposed carriage rank ought to be utilised as a pick up and drop off point, which will benefit both trades and other road users.

Thank you fro your correspondence regarding the new rank facility in Between Towns Road.

Whilst any new rank facility is welcomed by the trade, it has to be in the right place & at the right times of day, otherwise it will simply be ignored by cab drivers & cab users alike.

I realise this rank suddenly appeared overnight as if dropped by martians, it was without any element of consultation from the County Council, which does not surprise me in the leas.

I am disappointed that a rank suddenly appointed by the county is immediately backed up with double yellow lines through it, whilst every other rank around Oxford continues to be abused by private car & Private Hire drivers where yellow lines do NOT exist, however, it would appear that the county have failed yet again to require parking attendants to enforce the double yellows at Between Towns Road rendering the new facility useless.

Its a great pity that the county are not as eager to allow hackney carriages to ply their trade as they are bus operators.
