Delegate its powers under the Licensing Act 2003 and the Lotteries and

Amusements Act 1976 in relation to determining applications for amusements

- The Council has responsibility for determining applications for permits to operate amusements with prizes machines (Section 16 of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976).
- 2. The determining of such applications was made a 'licensing function' by the Licensing Act 2003 and therefore the responsibility of the Licensing and Gambling Acts Committee. Applications under Section 16 give the applicant the right to a hearing.
- 3. Applications under Section 16 are infrequent and none have been received by the Council in the recent past. However, two applications have now been received and require determination. The power to determine such applications has not previously been delegated to Licensing Casework Sub-committees.
- Licensing Casework Sub-committees deal with other hearings arising from the Licensing Act 2003 and would be the most suitable tribunal for dealing with hearings of this nature.
- 5. The applications for permits that have now been received require determination at a hearing. A hearing date has been provisionally set for January 9<sup>th</sup> 2007subject to the Committee delegating its powers to Licensing Casework Sub-committees.
- The Committee is being recommended to delegate its powers under the Licensing Act 2003 and the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 in relation to determination of applications for amusement with prizes permits received under Section 16 of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976.
