1. Gala Leisure Ltd, Bingo Hall, Ozone Leisure Park

Application granted for:

4. Gala Leisure Ltd, Bingo Hall, Ozone Leisure Park

Application granted for:
Gambling Act 2005 - Application to vary a Gambling Premises Licence 07/00816/PREM. To remove part of the area currently licensed for gaming from the ambit of the gaming licence. No extended opening hours.

5. The Corner Club (formally QI), 16/17 Turl Street

Application granted for:
Variation to Premises Licence 07/01045/PREM.
Alterations to the layout which also involves an increase of the licensed area, more particularly shown upon a plan lodged with the Local Authority.

6. Ping Pong, 33-35 George Street

Application granted for:
New Premises Licence. Ping Pong are a chain of eight restaurants. The application relates to a premises that are primarily to be used as a restaurant and bar with sales of alcohol and late night refreshment on the premises.

7. G&D's Café, 104 Cowley Road

Application granted for:
New Premises Licence. Situated on the Cowley Road, Oxford's G&D's is predominantly an ice cream cafe. We also sell hot and cold (non alcoholic) beverages, filled bagel sandwiches and have a range of home-made baked goods. Customers have the choice to either eat in or take away.

Late night refreshment from 23.00 hours until 00.15 hours.

8. Cherwell Filling Station, 3 Cherwell Drive

Application granted for:

New Premises Licence. A petrol forecourt store. The store sells a wide range of convenience store goods.

9. Rye St Antony School, Pullen's Lane

Application granted for:

Time Limited Premises Licence for a circus with no animals on the school playing fields on June 15 2008, 1pm to 6pm.

10. Golden Slumbers, Bossoms Boatyard

Application granted for:

New Premises Licence - New premises application for a river cruise boat Golden Slumbers to be operated between March and November each year between the hours of 10:00hours and 23:00hours seating a maximum of 12 people. Supply of alcohol is the only licensable activity.

11. Osler House Club, William Osler House, Osler Road

Application granted for:

Club Premises Certificate Application. Osler House Club. Application for the occasional showing of films, open music nights, parties with amplified music and dancing and sale of alcohol.

12. R&H Newsagents, 89 St Clement's Street

Application granted for:

New Premises Licence.

13. Risinghurst Community Centre, Kiln Lane

Application granted for:

New Premises Licence - New license for Risinghurst Community Centre licensable activities from 08:00hours to 00:00hours, application not for Sale of Alcohol.

Application granted for:

Variation to Premises Licence - extension to opening hours to midnight Sun to Thurs night and till 03:00am on Fri and Sat for late night refreshment.

15. Dominos Pizza, 57 Between Towns Road

Application granted for:

Variation to Premises Licence - Variation to extend opening hours for late night refreshment to midnight Sun to Thurs and 03:00am on Fri and Sat.

16. The Four Candles, 51-53 George Street

Application granted for:

Variation to Premises Licence 08/00560/TRPREM. Hours for licensable activities to commence at 09:00, 7 days a week. Removal of conditions in respect of alcohol, occupancy levels and CCTV requirements.

17. The White House, 2 Botley Road

Application withdrawn by applicant.

Application was for:

Variation to premises licence 05/00810/PREM The White House, 2 Botley Road, Oxford, OX2 0AB. The Premises Licence holder wishes to do the following:

1. Increase hours in which licensable activities will take place at the premises
2. Permit the provision of breakfast to customers and therefore vary the hours the premises is open to members of the public to run from 07.00 hrs each day
3. Permit later opening hours for the premises.

18. M&S Simply Food, Oxford Rail Station

Application granted for:

New Premises licence. Sale of alcohol and recorded music 07.00 hours to 23.00 hours.

19. Sahara, 11 Wheatsheaf Yard

Application granted for:

Variation to Premises Licence: 07/00319/PREM to extend the licensing hours to 01:00am Fri and Sat, and till midnight Sun to Thurs.

20. Majestic Wine Warehouse, 279 Cowley Road

Application granted for:

New Premises Licence - A substantial premises situated in a retail environment with stock displayed on pallets in an open plan layout. Majestic Wine Warehouse specializes in the sale of beer, wine and spirits for consumption off the premises. Sale of alcohol 08.00 hours to 23.00 hours.

21. Prince of Wales, Horspath Road

Application granted for:

Variation to premises licence 05/01048/PREM.

To amend condition 6, under annex 2 to read: "Persons under the age 16 will only be admitted if accompanied by a responsible adult who will be responsible for those under 16 whilst on the premises".

To amend condition 7, under annex 2 to read: "No person under the age of 18 is allowed in or at the bar servery area after 19.00, unless he/she is in the bar solely for the purpose of passing to or from some part of the premises which

is not a bar and to or from which there is no other convenient means of access or egress".

To amend condition 8, under annex 2 to read: "No person under the age of 18 is to be allowed to remain at the premises after 21:00 unless attending a private function at the premises".

To amend condition 12, under annex 2 to read: "There shall be no use of any outside area for licensable activities after 23:30 hours". Variation applied for to allow external part of the premises for smokers.

22. Hertford College Bar, Catte Street

Application granted for:

Club Premises certificate - Hertford College Bar exists for the current members of Hertford College and their guests to provide a pleasant venue for the purchase and consumption of alcoholic drinks in college. The bar premises are situated in a cellar under the building in "New Buildings" quad and are accessible only by college members.

23. Street Trader, Outside 65 St Giles

Application granted for:

New Premises Licence - for a catering trailer operating from specified location agreed with the council. Late night refreshment 23.00 hours to 03.00 hours.

24. Wadham Middle Common Room, 38 Holywell Street

Application granted for:

Premises Licence. 38 Holywell Street is to become Wadham College's Middle Common Room (MCR), having previously been leased as a restaurant known as 'Next Door' and the 'Holywells'.

25. Clementines, 15 St. Clements Street

Application granted for:

New premises licence. Due to extension of premises a new application for a licence has to be made. Clementines is a night club situated on the Plain roundabout over two floors (ground floor and basement). The application is for recorded music, provision of facilities for dancing and supply of alcohol. All these activities are from 11.00 hrs-03.00 hrs Monday to Saturday and 11.00 hrs- 02.00 hrs Sunday.

Sub-Committee Hearings

1. East Oxford Community Centre, Princes Street, Oxford

Application to vary Premises Licence 07/00994/PREM. Extension of opening hours in halls to include the sale of alcohol & late night refreshments, while community events are taking place at the Community Centre.

The Sub Committee took into account all submissions and evidence presented, both written and oral. They attached particular weight to the evidence of Thames Valley Police and Environmental Protection in relation to conditions necessary to address crime, disorder and nuisance. The Sub Committee agreed to GRANT the variation as applied for, subject to the following conditions being agreed between the applicant and responsible authorities.

2. The Regal, 300 Cowley Road, Oxford

Application to vary a Premises Licence 06/01097/PREM. Permit sale of alcohol during live performances, showing of plays, indoor sporting events, boxing, provision of facilities for making music. Live music events seven days a week.

Allowed for summer balls on 10 occasions between April and September.

The Sub Committee took into account all submissions and evidence presented, both written and oral. They attached particular weight to the evidence of Thames Valley Police and Environmental Protection in relation to conditions necessary to address crime, disorder and nuisance, and noted that conditions had now been agreed with the applicant. The Sub Committee were satisfied that the variations requested would promote the licensing objectives, and amended the variation application was therefore granted.

3. The Fir Tree, 163 Iffley Road, Oxford

Application to vary a premises licence 05/00765/PREM. To add New Years Eve to Live Music, Recorded Music and Facilities for Dancing. To vary the hours for Late Night Refreshment to include Sun to Mon and New Years Eve. To add Facilities for Making Music and Exhibition of a Film. To amend condition 4 under Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule to read: "No outside area shall be used for consumption of alcohol or provision of regulated entertainment unless a the area is clearly marked or defined. On days that the premises are open for the sale of alcohol, any outside area shall not be used for consumption of alcohol after 23:00 hours. To amend condition 4 under Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule to read: No persons shall be admitted to the premises less than 30 minutes before cessation of last licensable activities. To attach the amended licence plan to show works which include the new corridor leading to the rear area and the smoking solution.

The Sub Committee took into account all submissions and evidence presented, both written and oral. They attached particular weight to the evidence of Environmental Protection in relation to conditions necessary to address public nuisance, and noted that conditions had now been agreed with the applicant. They also noted existing condition 10 of the licence, which restricted noise levels from regulated entertainment. The Sub Committee were satisfied that the variations requested would promote the licensing objectives, and the variation application was therefore granted with the following conditions.

4. Domino's Pizza, 126 London Road, Oxford

Variation for extension to late night refreshment hours to midnight Sunday to Thursday and to 03:00am on Friday and Saturday.

The Sub Committee took into account all submissions and evidence presented, both written and oral. The Sub Committee found that there were existing noise problems resulting from late night operation of the premises, in particular the arrival and departure of delivery drivers and delivery of raw materials in the early hours. Allowing the variation would be likely to aggravate these problems. Until the problems were addressed and in the absence of the any measures proposed in the application to mitigate them, the Sub Committee felt it would be unacceptable and contrary to the licensing objective of preventing public nuisance to allow the premises to operate beyond its current hours. Taking these factors into account, the Sub Committee therefore REFUSED the application.

5. The White Hart, 12 St Andrews Road, Oxford

Variation to licence 05/00946/PREM. To remove the condition "External areas must not be used by customers after 23:00 hours" and to re-read: "the garden area must not be used by customers after 23:00 hours. The external smoking area must not be used by customers for licensable activity after 23:00 hours."

The Sub Committee took into account all submissions and evidence presented, both written and oral. The Sub Committee appreciated the concerns of the Interested Parties but also recognised that the applicant was required to comply with the provisions of the Health Act 2006 (smoking ban). The Sub Committee agreed to GRANT the application. Condition 11 of the current licence to be removed.
