- 16 Drug Dog Operations carried out in the City and East Oxford (12 paid for by Nightsafe)
- 6 Multi Agency Inspections carried out in the City and East Oxford. (Team consist of Police, Trading Standards, Fire & Rescue, Council Licensing and Nightsafe Manager)
- 1 of the 4 people who developed the county wide Alcohol Strategy 2008 - 2011
- Chair the enforcement sub group of the Alcohol Tactical Business Group
- Worked in conjunction with Jack Fm to design 20,000 car stickers which were distributed in July by their promotion teams
- Provided Lock Em Leaflets and Website bookmarks for student packs prior to starting at university – July 08
- Helped to organise and par-took in a two week county wide test purchasing operation which was an action from the Alcohol Tactical Business Group. Aug 08
- Working in conjunction with Gwen to add two new sections onto the Nightsafe Website. There is now a young peoples & parents section as well as News Section which includes “Karen’s Blog”! . Aug 08
- Conducted research and held meetings around Purple Flag, which is a Civic Trust Award for the Night Time Economy. The CDRP have agreed to fund and I will now take this forward with all the other partners involved , work will start in the New Year. Sept 08 - ongoing
- Launch of the Licensed premises Banned Scheme for the city in conjunction with OX1 and Pub Watch. Sept 08
- Student Operation – Three phase operation 1) hi vis policing (included Horses & drugs dog team 2) radio campaign 3) Brookes Fresher Fair. All aimed at setting the level of acceptable behaviour from university students - Oct 08
- Commissioned with TVP a 60 second advert that was played in the Westgate Centre during half term, the commercial was aimed at reducing knife crime. This formed part of the requested action from TVP HQ & Home office re knife crime. Oct 08
- Funded the launch production of Gemma’s Wardrobe with the county education department. The play will shown across secondary schools in the county and explores the issues around drug taking and its wider effects on friends & family. Nov 08
- Member of a working group looking at the TVP Violent Action Plan for Oxfordshire – Nov 08 - ongoing
- Christmas Radio Campaign with JACK FM – three weeks of short, sharp messages around drinking safely and the consequences of getting arrested etc Dec 08

- Mini Christmas Campaign, which will run in conjunction with standard Operation Nightsafe. 11th & 12th December Drug dog operations in the city & East Oxford, 18th additional hi vis patrols and 19th Drug Dog Operation in East Oxford. This hits one of the NAG priorities in both areas which is Drug Taking and Dealing – Dec 08
- Assisting the DAAT and PCT in a pilot project, which involves SMART workers offering advice to those who present to A & E with alcohol abuse issues. This is being funded by PCT and will be evaluated in the New Year with the hope that this will become common practice at the JR. Dec 08
- NAG – taking a strategic part in both the city and East Oxford as Anti-social behaviour, night time economy and drugs features in the top three of both – on going
- Working nights with CCU officers and CBO in East Oxford to ensure that I am aware of the problems/issues that are occurring in the night time economy. – On going
