Cycling Review Group - Draft Project Scope

Rationale	Cycling is a priority review topic for the City Council's Scrutiny Committee. Oxford is acknowledged as one of the few true 'Cycling Cities' in the UK but barriers to cycling remain including the limited availability of secure cycle parking and the general experience of cycling on heavily-trafficked roads.
Purpose of Review/Objective	The primary purpose of the review is to inform how the City Council can maximise the impact of its unallocated Cycling investments (£50k in 2016/17) on improving cycling take up, safety and connectivity. The Review Group aims to do this by engaging with relevant experts and producing a costed priority list of recommended cycling improvements. Secondary objectives are to: Produce a 'wish list' of additional priority schemes that go beyond the £50k. Consider the merits of further City Council investments beyond 2016/17. Consider the level of revenue needed to support the delivery of capital schemes. Consider mechanisms to make sure that cycle routes and provision are considered in planning decisions. Understand what research data already exists. Understand and seek to influence the County Council's cycling priorities. Influence a cycling event to be held in summer 2015. Explore the feasibility and cost of cycling apps and abandoned bike recycling schemes.
