

Welcome to the East Area Planning Committee

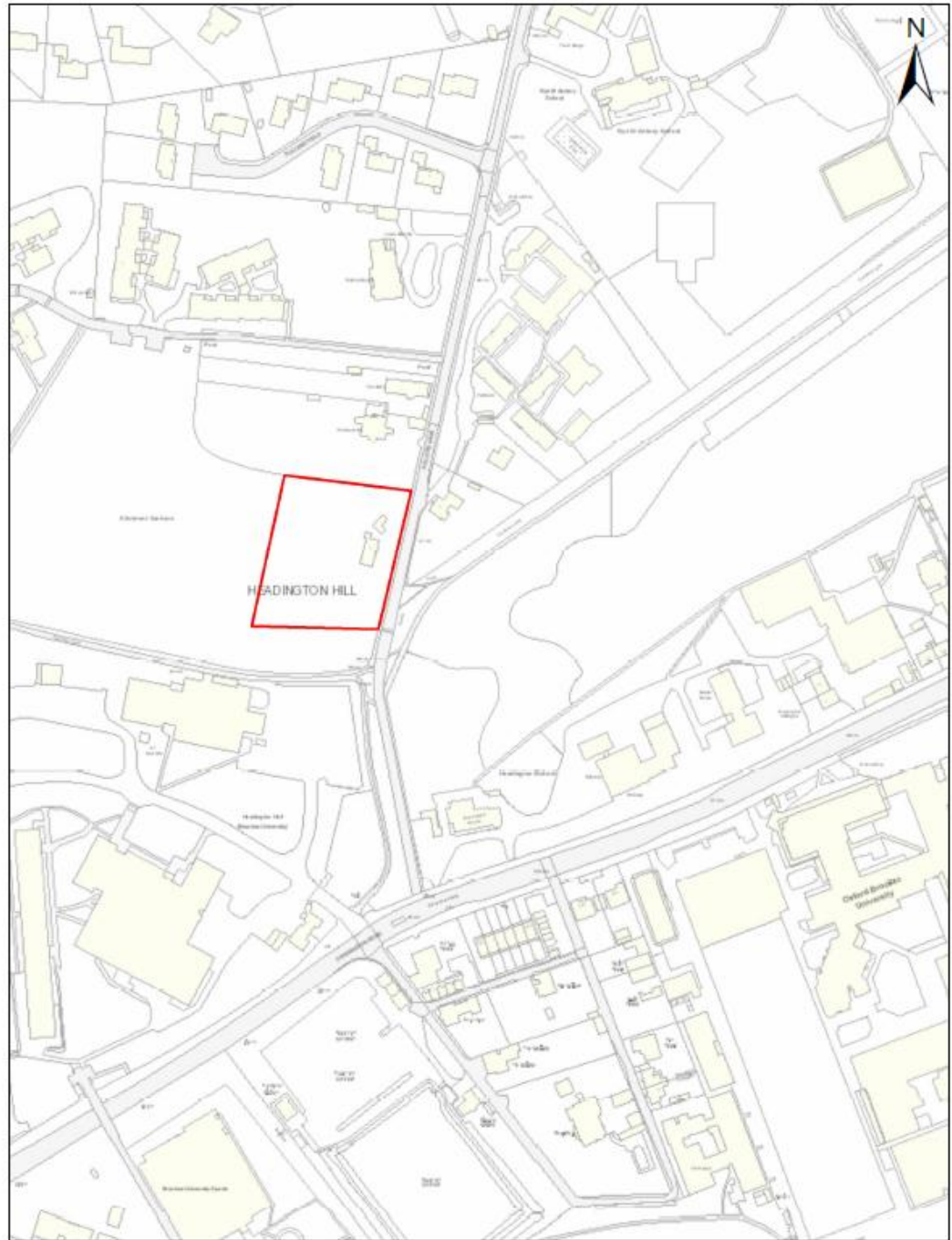
- This planning committee meeting is held in public, but it is not a public meeting.
