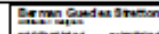


# Welcome to the West Area Planning Committee

- This is in the committee agenda just before the first planning application report.



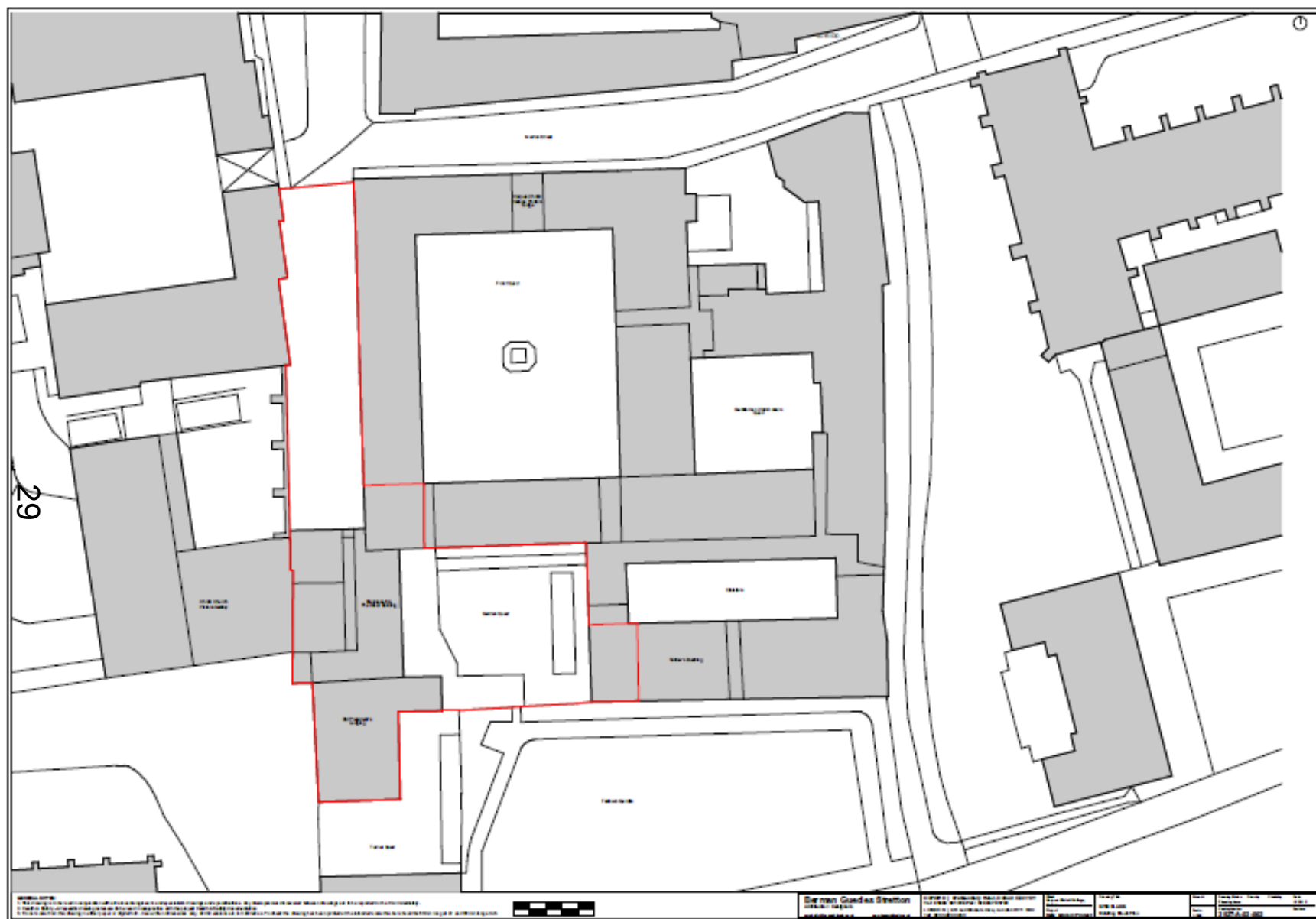
