CAR PARKS ADJACENT TO PARKS - CHARGING, PERMITS AND CONTROL OF USE

- 1. The Oxford City Council, with the consent of the Oxfordshire County Council, proposes to make a Parking Place Order, the title of which appears below.
- 2. The effect of the Order will be to introduce pay and display parking charges and concessionary permit parking arrangements as follows at the car parks listed below:-

Car parks affected

Alexandra Courts, Middle Way; Cutteslowe Park, Harbord Road; Cutteslowe Park, Elsfield Way; Hinksey Park, Abingdon Road; Marsh Road; Walton Well Road.

Pay and display charges

Alexandra Courts, Hinksey Park and Walton Well Road	Cutteslowe Park (both car parks) and Marsh Road
0-1 hour - 50p	0-1 hour - 50p
1-3 hours - £1	1-3 hours - £1
3-5 hours - £2	3-24 hours - £2
5-24 hours - £10	

A vehicle shall not be permitted to return to the car park within 3 hours of a previous period of parking in it.

Concessionary permit parking arrangements

All car parks:-

- A member of a club affiliated to a sports ground or facility or amenity adjacent to the car park can apply for a permit. A permit will cost £20 per year. A permit will be valid for one car park only and may be used only when an event associated with the club is taking place at the sports ground or facility or amenity.
- A regular user of the sports ground or facility or amenity adjacent to the car
 park can apply for a permit. A permit will cost £50 per year. A permit will be
 valid for one car park only and may be used only when the permit holder is
 using the facilities of the sports ground or adjacent amenities.
- A holder of a Slice Card can apply for a permit. A permit will cost £20 per year. A permit will be valid for one car park only and may be used only when the permit holder is using the facilities at the sports ground or adjacent amenities.

Marsh Road only:-

Any person employed at the Cowley Marsh Depot can apply for a permit. A
permit will be free of charge and may be used only when the employee is
working at the depot.

Walton Well Road only:-

• The current permit arrangements for holders of permits issued by Bossoms Boatyard on behalf of the Council will apply. Holders of such permits will be exempt from the pay and display charges at the car park.

Hinksey Park only:-

• The current permit arrangements will be varied. All vehicles will be subject to pay and display charges. However, users of the adjacent swimming pool who wish to use the pool for more than 5 hours may obtain a permit to park for more than 5 hours at no additional charge. Thus, the charge for parking for swimming pool users will be capped at £2.

Excess and penalty charges

Excess and penalty charges will apply to all car parks. The charge will be £100 reduced to £50 for prompt payment. The charges will apply for non-display of a parking ticket or permit, overstaying the time purchased, return to the car park within 3 hours of leaving it, and where the vehicle is causing an obstruction, is parked in a reserved or closed parking space or is of an unauthorised class.

- 3.Full details of the proposals may be seen in the draft Order which is available for inspection at my office at the address given below between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.00 pm on Mondays to Fridays. A copy of the Council's statement of reasons and of this notice may also be examined in my office between the hours mentioned above. The documents available for public inspection will be placed on the agenda display stand on the right of the main entrance to the Town Hall.
