What decision needs to be taken?

Acceptance of Indicative proposals for development of an e-Government Strategy, to form part of the Council's policy framework. This will take the form of an Implementing Electronic Government Statement 2 (IEG2). This report appears in the Forward Plan for Executive Board on 30 September.

What are the reasons for the decision?

IEG2 is the means by which we are able to bid for a second capital grant of £200,000 for the development of e-government work. This must be submitted to the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister (ODPM) by 31 October 2002.

Why is it in the best interests of the Authority?

The Government have set all local authorities the target of having 100% of those services that can be delivered by electronic means enabled to do so by the end of 2005. The aim is to provide better access to improved services by exploiting the power of information and communications technologies to help transform the accessibility, cost-effectiveness and quality of public services.

To do this will require significant organisational and cultural change as well as adopting new technologies. The IEG grant will make a major contribution to our ability to resource this work.

What alternative courses of action have been considered and why were they not taken?

The IEG2 statement must be approved by Council prior to submission to ODPM at the end of October.

In order to allow a 4 week period for consultation before the deadline for submission of papers to Council for approval on 14 October, these indicative proposals must be approved before the 5 September.

Ideally the Indicative proposals would be the subject of a report to Executive Board; it is not possible for this deadline to be met through that route.
