

## **APPENDIX C.**

### **Grant Allocations to Voluntary and Community Organisations 2006/2007.**

1. Area Committees considered those grant applications whose activities primarily benefited their areas during the January / February cycle of meetings. Some Area Committees have requested that additional grants be made.
2. The options available to Executive Board are:
  - o To fund the increases by deducting the amount from another organisation listed in Appendix B.
  - o To fund the increase by deducting the amount from the earmarked small / emergency grants or arts development funds.
  - o Not to fund the increases.
  - o Refer back to area committees for support from area committee revenue budgets.

The comments are summarised below and Executive Board are requested to reach a decision on each of the following:

#### **North East Area Committee**

To provide a total of £2,200 additional funding to be allocated as:

Wood Farm Youth Centre – to provide additional grant funding of £1500 (£500 grant agreed by NE Area Committee 24/01/06)  
Cowley Amateur Boxing Club – to agree additional grant funding of £700 (no grant recommended)

#### **Cowley Area Committee**

To provide a total of £2,250 additional funding to be allocated as:

Florence Park Bowls Club – to provide additional grant funding of £2,250 (£3,750 grant agreed by Cowley Area Committee 01/02/06)

#### **South East Area Committee**

To provide a total of £34,400 additional funding to be allocated as:

Pathways Workshop (£34,400 requested, no grant recommended).

To pass on to the Executive Board the Committee's concern at the sharp reduction in the proposed funding for the Blackbird Leys Bowls Club (£1,500 grant agreed, £3,300 drop from previous year).

#### **East Area Parliament**

EAP requested clarification of the amount shown as unrestricted reserves within East Oxford Community Association's (EOCC) accounts. The organisations accountant has explained that these reserves are not liquid assets and are therefore unavailable to be used by the Trustees. EOCC have

reduced their request to £5,000. Executive Board are asked to take this information into consideration and come to a decision about the request.
