ndorse the Older Peoples Housing Strategy to go out for consultation as specified.

This strategy follows on from the City Council review of Older Peoples

Services, which was endorsed by Executive Board at the beginning of 2006. This review primarily considered accommodation and services managed by the City Council and some of the recommendations from that review have been incorporated into this Strategy. However the strategy recommends improvements to services for all older people in Oxford

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regardless of tenure. The strategy refers closely to the new Private Sector strategy, which seeks to improve the condition of housing in the private sector, and targets housing occupied by older people as a priority group.
