Local Plan policies that refer to planning obligations but in practice would in the majority of cases be secured by condition rather than a planning obligation or for other reasons specified.

(In accordance with Circular advice where there is a choice between imposing conditions and entering into a planning obligations, the imposistion of a condition is preferable).

The following issues may be included in planning obligations in fairly rare, bespoke circumstances.
