- 1. The Community Centre Strategy has been under development over the last two years.
- 2. This process has involved four principal drafts, and substantial changes to the document.
- 3. The attached Appendix 1 represents a version which has been consulted upon with Community Associations and the Federation of Community Associations, and incorporates the changes of the portfolio holder, strategic director, area co-ordinators, other officers and members.
- 4. The Four Step Action Plan on the first page of Appendix 1 outlines a way forward for community centres using the Community Matters' "VISIBLE" process and a timeline under which community centres work with area committees and community centre managers to achieve the essential criteria. A parallel buildings audit is also proposed.
- 5. Area and Scrutiny Committees have been asked to endorse the use of the independent VISIBLE framework and to comment on the approach of the strategy, mindful of the fact that finance and staffing implications might flow from the recommendations.
- 6. Comments received to date are set out in Appendix 2 and any further comments received will be available at the meeting.
