Title of Report: Write Off Report Of Uncollectable Debts (General Fund)

### **Summary and Recommendations**

**Purpose of report**: To agree write-off of debts in excess of £10,000 for Business debt and £5,000 for non-Business debts. The cases submitted for write off are presented in accordance with the debt write off policy agreed by Executive Board on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2004.

**Policy Framework**: The report supports the Council vision as it will contribute to maintaining Financial stability.

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#### 1. Introduction

In an average year Oxford collects £170m of income. This total includes £70m in business rates, £55m in council tax and £25m in housing related rents. Benefit overpayments, commercial rents and day-to-day debts make up the rest of this total.

Some people and organisations do not pay what they owe and, though we chase these accounts, some debts will not be recoverable. Officers have gone back over aged debts and worked out which cannot be realistically recovered. This report recommends those irrecoverable debts are written off - in line with normal commercial practice. The debts will be written off against provisions that have been set aside over the years for this specific purpose.

The cases submitted for write off are shown below, indicating the type of write off, the reason and the amount.
