- 1. City Works want to purchase replacement vehicles in 2007/08 to the approximate value of £2,877,700 in the approved Capital Programme.
- 2. Executive Board report 8<sup>th</sup> January 2007 outlined the method for funding vehicle purchases for 2007/08 and future years.
