Budget

ghbourhood Renewal holds a number of budgets for grants to voluntary and community groups. One of these budgets is for the allocation of small or rgency grants throughout the year, after the main grants allocation has been decided at the start of the financial year.

Community and voluntary groups can apply for a small grant up to £500 or an emergency grant up to £5,000.

# 2. Grants Budgets

# 3. Small / Emergency Grants Paid

Previously, for speed of decision-making, the small and emergency grants have been allocated with the approval of the Business Manager under delegated powers. To date 5 small grants have been paid out, listed below in Table 1.

It has come to light that this practice has not been consistent with the powers allowed under the new constitution. This report asks Executive Board to retrospectively approve the small grants paid this financial year, as shown in Table 1, above.

# **4.** Small / Emergency Grant Applications Received July 2007 Balance for round 2 small grant applications £3,359. Balance for contingency applications £14,740.

Thirteen applications were received. The panel recommended declining 11 and approving 2. The panel took this view based on the budget remaining to be allocated for 2007/2008. Only those scoring 30 or above were recommended. If these recommendations are approved, a total of £2,359 will remain for allocation of small grants for 2007/2008 and £14,740 for contingency/emergency grants. Table 2 shows applications received July 2007.
