Sommendation(s): This report informs the Board of a request from The Porch Steppin' Stone Centre asking for City Council resentation on its Management Committee, either as a voting member or an observer and RECOMMENDS that one representative be nominated as a non-voting observer.	

The Porch has contacted me to ask the Board to consider appointing a representative to its Steppin' Stone centre management committee either as a voting member or non-voting observer.

2. The Stepping' Stone Centre provides day long support for homeless and vulnerably housed people wanting to move forward in their lives,

away from street-life and addiction. It is open every day of the week except Wednesday.

Its mission is to help homeless, recently housed or vulnerably housed people. It encourages its members to tackle the issue of apathy, addiction and unemployment, and to move forward towards a positive lifestyle. It also provides healthy food, practical help, companionship, learning skills and opportunities for development.

- 3. For some time now, the Council's policy, when considering appointing to new bodies, has been to appoint as a non-voting observer, to avoid any risk of liability to the nominee. If the Board is minded to nominate to this body I would recommend it be as a non-voting observer.
- 4. The Board is recommended to nominate one representative to the Porch Steppin' Stone Centre as a non-voting observer.
