Motion adopted at a meeting of the full City Council on 18th February 2008:-

Radley Lakes

Councillor Dhall seconded by Councillor Phelps moved the following Motion on Notice:-

"This Council notes the amenity value of Radley Lakes for residents of Oxford and acknowledges that the Save Radley Lakes campaign counts many Oxford residents amongst its supporters.

This Council therefore opposes the current plans to use the area as a dumping ground for fuel ash and regrets the decision of the County Council not to register Radley Lakes as a Town Green – which would have offered some protection.

Council therefore asks Executive Board to consider ways in which the City Council might support any action that may be taken by other local authorities in Oxfordshire, such as Abingdon Town and Radley Parish Councils, to fight for the preservation of Radley Lakes".

Following a debate Council voted upon the Motion and this was carried, more members voting in favour of the Motion than voting against.
