- of lease for less than best consideration, which may apply in this case, are a matter for the City Executive Board.
- 3. It is preferable that a single report be presented to a single decision making body for all the elements of the scheme and the Board are therefore invited to confirm that the Area Committee should be delegated the executive responsibility to enable that to happen.
- 4. It is anticipated that a comprehensive report will be presented to the North East Area Committee in early February 2009.
