Title of Report:

Amendment to Fees & Charges - Pest Control

Summary and Recommendations

Purpose of report: To request that fees & charges are amended to allow a number of pest control products to be available for sale to the customer. This will improve the options available to Pest Control Officers in the on-going prevention of pests and therefore improve the service available for the customer.

Recommendation(s):

- 1. To agree that extra pest control products can be available for sale to the customer, as part of the prevention and treatment of pests by the pest control service
- 2.To agree to the amendment of Fees & Charges for these extra products as outlined in the report.

Introduction

1. The Pest Control Service carries out treatments in domestic and commercial premises across the city. Treatments are carried out to control and prevent problems with pests, the most common being rats, mice, bedbugs and cockroaches

Background

- 2. Following a procurement exercise to establish value for money in relation to pest products, the principal supplier for pest control products was changed.
- 3. The change of supplier has identified a number of innovative products that are on the market. These products will aid in resolving a number of recurring pest problems for our customers and enhance the Pest Control Service provided.

Corporate Priorities

- 4. The addition of the new pest control products and the associated improvement in the Pest Control Service provided would assist in the delivery of the following Oxford City Council Corporate Priorities:
 - a) Improve the local environment, economy and quality of life
 - b) Transform Oxford City Council by improving value for money and service performance

Proposed Products for Addition to Fees & Charges

5. See appendix 1 for a list of the proposed products, their uses, benefits, alternatives and cost to the customer.

Financial Implications

- 6. The products will be offered for sale at the recommended retail price so that the customer is paying a competitive price for the products they are receiving. The customer will be under no obligation to purchase the products
- 7. Following the successful procurement exercise a discount has been negotiated with the supplier on the purchase of the products that will cover carriage charge and other associated administration costs. The proposals are therefore cost neutral for the service.

Legal Implications

- 8. The supplier is an ISO9001 accredited company.
- The sale of these products will be incidental to the council's powers and duties to keep the city so far as is practicable free from pests under Public Health legislation

Climate Change/Environmental Impact

- 10 This proposal would reduce the city's carbon footprint by providing products directly to the customer that they would otherwise travel to purchase or have delivered in a separate vehicle. By delivering the products at the same time as a scheduled pest control visit any additional carbon used by extra transport will be reduced.
- 11 The mattress cover product would prevent the need for treated mattresses to be destroyed therefore reducing the environmental impact of disposing of the mattress and the associated impact of having a new one delivered.

Risk Assessment

12 A risk assessment has been undertaken and the risk register is attached as Appendix 2.

Equalities Impact

- 13 It is not anticipated that these products will have an impact on the equality of the service provided. The pest control service is available to all Oxford residents and is subsidised for residents in receipt of prescribed benefits.
- 14 No changes to the basic pest control service will be made under these proposals and a free service for the treatment of rats and mice will continue to be provided.
- 15 Those people in receipt of financial aid will benefit equally from these products as all other customers. These products are competitively priced and do not effect the existing concessions made for people in receipt of prescribed benefits.

Stock Levels

16 See appendix 2 for anticipated take up levels and predicted stock levels.

Review

17 A review of the new products will be conducted after 6 months to measure the success of the products and then every year after that to ensure that the customer is getting the best possible price.

Recommendation

18 It is recommended that

- a) Extra pest control products can be available for sale to the customer, as part of the prevention and treatment of pests by the pest control service
- b) to agree to the amendment of Fees & Charges as outlined in the report.
