Summary and Recommendations

Purpose of report: To ask the Board to agree an initial response to the Boundary Commission on its electoral review of Oxfordshire County Council.

Recommendation(s): The City Executive Board is recommended to agree its response as follows:

- a) that the City Council commends the status quo of two members per city division, totalling 16, and comments that it would be perverse to change that as a consequence of attempting to put right an anomaly in Witney;
- b) that whatever scheme is approved that the co-terminosity between wards and divisions should be maintained.

1. Background and supporting information

1.1 The Boundary Commission for England has commenced an Electoral Review of Oxfordshire County Council. This is outside the normal programme of periodical electoral reviews and was triggered by an anomaly in the size of electoral divisions in Witney.

- 1.2 The County Council has asked that the divisions within Witney be reviewed and not the remainder of the County, but the Commission has rejected this approach and is carrying out a full review.
- 1.3 Set out below is the timetable for the review. The Commission has asked for initial responses on council size by 22nd November. This review will not affect any ward boundaries.
