OJEU Tender Procedure

Open

Open procedure is generally used when the contracting authority anticipates that competition is likely to be very limited because of the few known suppliers or the specialist nature of the goods or services. This increases the level of interest and competition to the maximum available since the all interested suppliers are invited to tender.

Restricted

Restricted procedure as name suggests restricts the number of competitors that the contracting authority permits to enter the competition. This procedure is most commonly used by UK government departments.

Competitive Dialogue

Competitive dialogue selected when the purchasing organisation has not agreed the final specification requirement and may engaging in dialogue with one or more suppliers to negotiate the terms and conditions of the contract.
