General Purposes Licensing Committee – Powers and Duties

- 1. To establish, develop and keep under review all of the Council's licensing policies for the function set out in the relevant parts of the Local Authorities (Functions and Responsibilities) (England) Regulations 2000 and any subsequent Regulations, subject to the duty of Council to agree new Council policy and variations to it for inclusion in the Policy Framework.
- 2. To set and keep under review fees for licences where the Council has a power to do so.
- To determine licence applications where the Environmental Health Business Manager in consultation with the Legal and Democratic Services Business Manager, the Chair of the relevant casework committee and the Chair of this Committee considers there are appropriate reasons for the Committee to do so.
- 4. To appoint the Public Entertainment and Other Matters Licensing (casework) Sub-Committee and the Hackney Carriages and Private Hire Licensing (casework) Sub-Committee.
