









Roof Level Detail: Buildings 2 and 3

















South Square Looking West from Ground Level

New north from Speedwell Street along Norfolk Street. The quality of the materials is evident in the paying, the split-stone plinth, reconstituted stone shopfront surrounds and brick cladding.



Night view along Speedwell Street with only discrete elements of the facade illuminated.




View across Old Greyfrians Street towards Greyfrians Lane, the new route leading to South Square

Shopfronts activate the facades along Greyfrians Lane as it approaches South Square from the east.








Circulation at end of upper walkway, looking south towards Speedwell Street with covered access to the lifts serving basement parking and restaurant levels.






Speedwell Street and Thames Street Public Realm and Highways Plan






