2 sets of 5 designs sports hall side wall along walk way to entrance and wall facing carpark

Image digital printed 2000mm squareon plastic foil placed in 1mm steel tray retainer 11mm deep covered by 10mm toughend glass to form image panel.


Image panel inserted into brushed steel finished frame 100mm with 60mm returns, rasied off wall 15mm, fixed on wall by hinged backet on left, so frame can be swung open to access back to change image. Frame fixed righthand side to wall bracket.




