**Addendum to Item 11 Cabinet responses to Scrutiny recommendations**

1. Following points raised by Councillor Jarvis during the Full Council meeting on 23 March 2026, the Chair of Scrutiny Committee amended a recommendation on Nighttime Economy to include trade unions alongside employers when engaging with agencies regarding the safety of late night workers.
2. The amended recommendation and response from Cabinet is set out below:

<p>5) That the Council continues to engage with employers <b>and trade unions alike</b> to identify how best to address the issues faced by workers travelling home late at night.</p>	<p>Yes</p>	<p>The Council will continue to engage with employers and Thames Valley Police where feasible.  <b>Response to the amended recommendation:</b>  <i>Trade unions represent workers in the night time economy and often highlight particular issues that impact on their members in campaigns at a national level. Giving trade unions an opportunity to engage with the City Council to highlight their campaigns would be mutually beneficial. The Council is therefore happy to include trade unions in its engagement with agencies on this issue within its resources.</i></p>
