These consultations informed the draft SPD, which which was consulted on during an 8 week period ending on 17th April 2015. Previous contacts and general planning contacts were notified directly. Drop in sessions with officers were held at the North Oxford Association and the Summertown Farmers' Market. A comment form was provided and a summary of responses will be attached to this report.
