- 1. The vehicle, both inside and out is of smart appearance to help promote Oxford City as a visually appealing safe place to eat;**
- 2. The trading name is visible on three sides so that people approaching the vehicle by car or on foot can clearly see the name;**
- 3. Mr Cacan is aware that all persons irrelevant of physical or other challenges may wish to order food and he can accommodate everybody. For example, entrance to and from the food vehicle is very easy making it simple for Mr Cacan to serve persons with mobility challenges i.e. those using a wheelchair;**
- 4. The vehicle is fully insured, gas safe checked, and all equipment is in good working order and repair;**
- 5. Mr Cacan has completed the new Safer Food Better Business (SFBB) document to ensure food safety. In addition Mr Cacan has watched the SFBB food safety DVD, and has received further practical training from a consultant so as to ensure all food safety requirements are met;**
- 6. The menu is to be reviewed to ensure any raw meat handling is minimised to avoid cross-contamination. For example handling of raw burgers is easily done via colour coded red tongs;**
- 7. The menu is also being designed so food can be prepared and served quickly to ensure there is no customer build-up thereby minimising customer build-up helping to maintain public order and minimise noise;**
- 8. Licensed commercial waste disposal company Oxford Direct Services (ODS), have confirmed that they can collect and dispose of Mobilr vehicle commercial waste, and recycle any food waste. ODS are unable to collect oil waste. If a street consent is granted, the consent will be forwarded to ODS (they will not set up a contract otherwise) and a contract set-up. Oil waste will be contracted out to a separate company for collection;**
- 9. Mr Cacan has employed consultant Richard Johns, Bsc (Hons), DIS, CMCIEH, EHORB registration 3262, to ensure all necessary requirements are met. This has included Mr Johns inspecting the vehicle and practices to be undertaken. Amongst other matters, full consideration has been given to the Food Hygiene (England) Regulations 2006, 852/2004, 178/2004, The Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 (and relevant regulations), the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and the Street Trading Policy.**

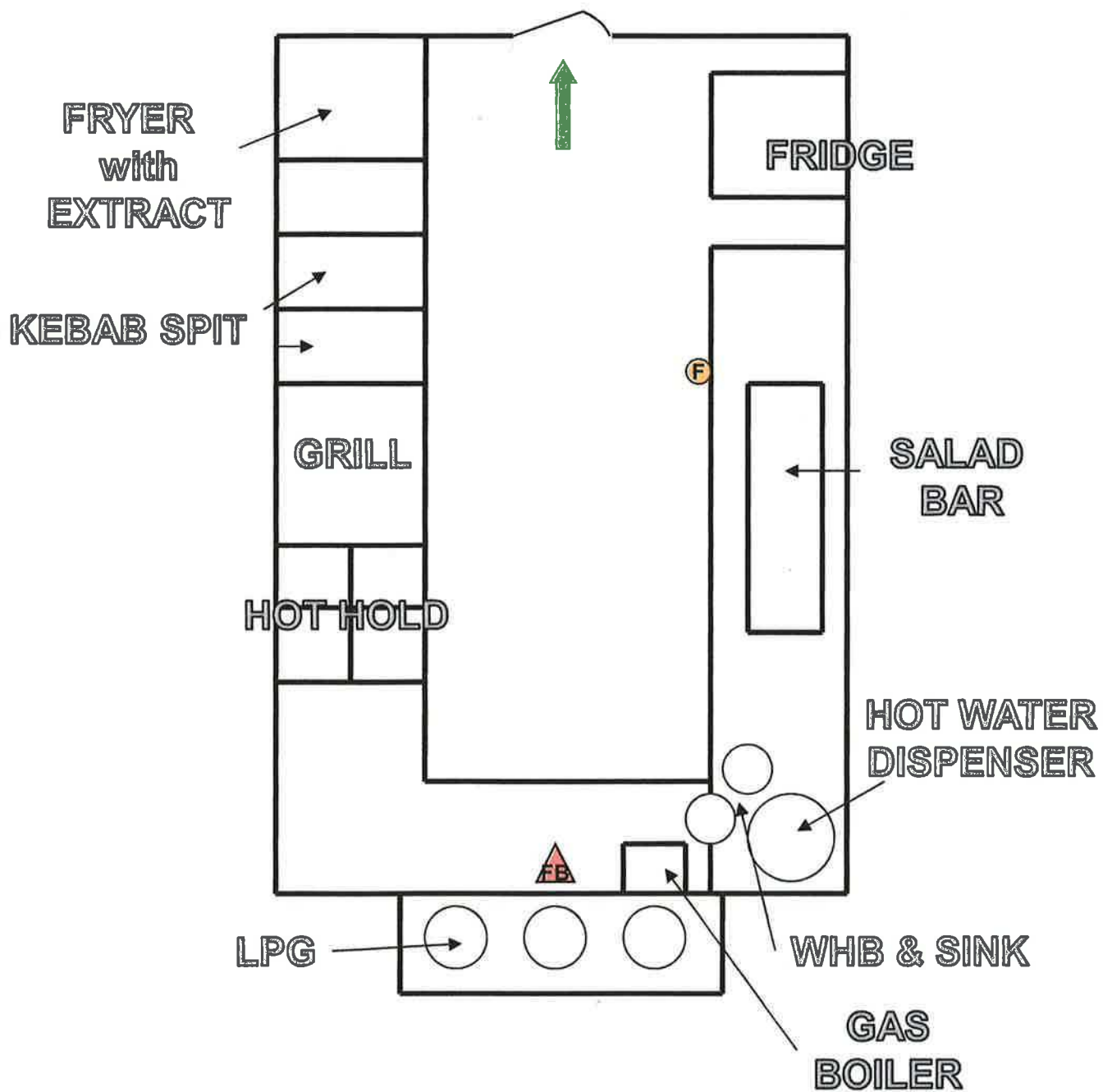



Hassan Khalil has been a volunteer chef for several years for two refugee charities (see attached letters from Asylum Welcome and Open Door). Through Open Door he has had access to Food Safety training and will also be able to arrange a top-up. He plans to provide information about refugee charities on the van and fund-raise with a fixed collecting box. Once the business is well established he would like to look at other ways of fundraising for refugee charities, perhaps by a price supplement attached to a particular dish.

The Applicant has experience as a chef over 10 years in a number of settings – cafes, fish and chip shops, hospital, colleges and work canteens. Both the workers have experience of kebab vans.

When running his café in East Oxford he got to know PCSO Helen Duffield, who also visits Open Door regularly as part of her area. In the same way, he would aim to get to know the city centre Police team so as to have the best advice about who to call if necessary.
