Our trailer

We have recently brought a catering trailer which is fully equipped with stainless steel inside and top of the range equipment. This has been fully fitted wih the established company - Towability

Oxfords residents and students clearly love the popular foods which are, kebabs, burgers and hotdogs, therefore, we have been meeping to these favourites by continuing to sell these foods. I currently order and collect agock from these suppliers so i am very experienced in dealing with these suppliers.

Money

We have been able to pay the licence fees on time with no problem

Since trading in the pitch at St Giles since January 2013 we have made sufficient income for the quarterly council rates cost and a good profit for living expenses.

Why us?

We have been interested in the high street pitch for a long time and we have enquired about this pitch many times

Our food range has proved popular wih many customers however, we think our food would be much better suited being sold at high street as there ls more footfall and many of our regular customers we do have live or study in or close to high street

The prices we sell our food, match the quality of food we sell however, with the traders selling close by in Woodstock road and st Giles, our prices are higher, which is losing us a lot of customers. The traders in and close to high street all have the same or similar prices of some of the food , which will make it easier to trade in high street

We think high street is perfect for our food range, our current clientele and our prices. Obviously income is important and we want to continue to sell quality food but without the right location, it will be difficult to continue to sell the food range we currently have

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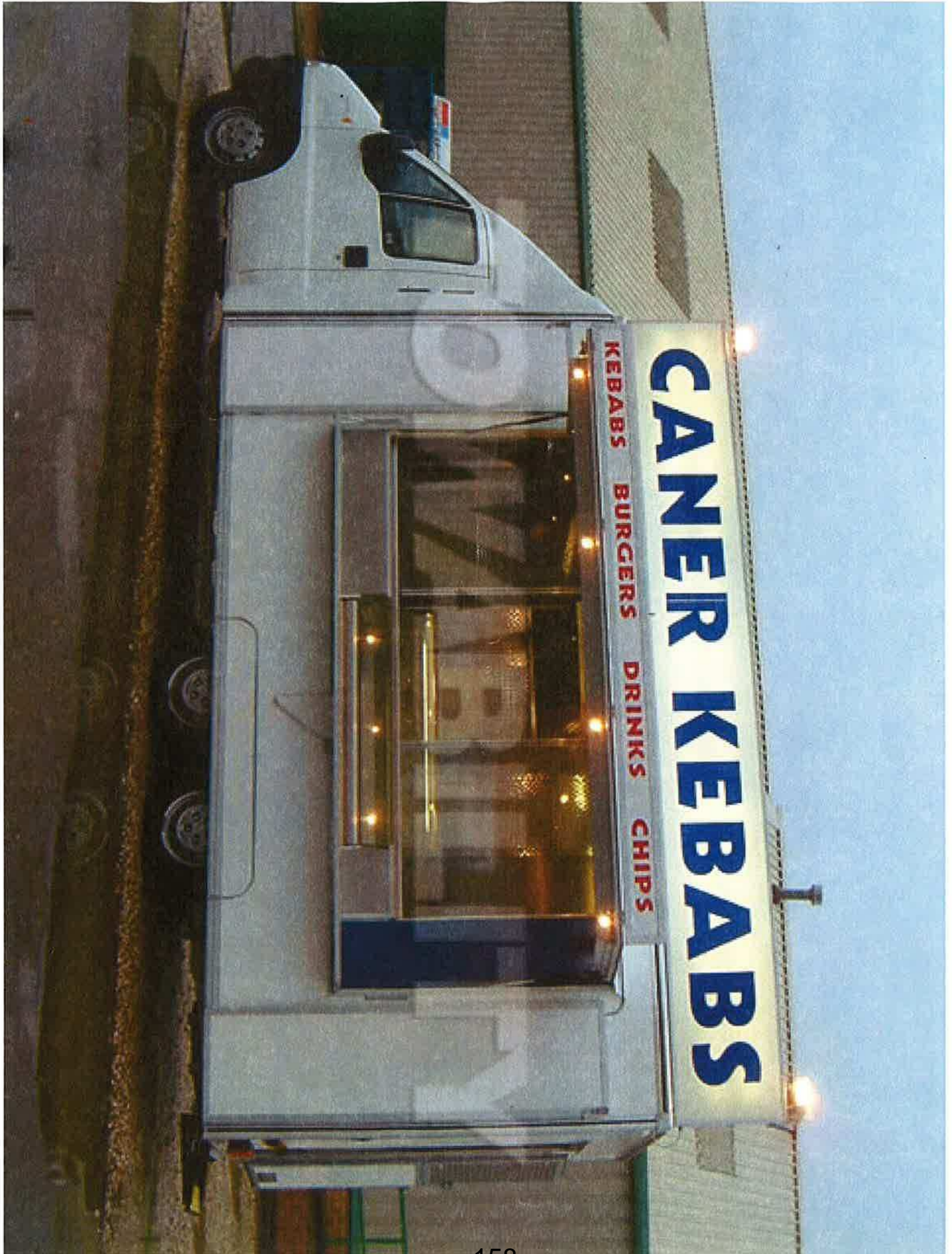
