Introduction

1. The Scrutiny Committee considered the proposals for the acquisition of a strip of riverside land adjacent to Abbey Road by adverse possession. They were supported in their debate by John Copley; the Committee would like to thank him for his time and advice.
2. The Committee also heard from a group of residents living near to this river strip who are concerned about the on-going damage caused to the bank by unauthorized mooring. This riverbank provides the main flood defence for their properties and current activity has the potential to significantly undermine this. The residents made 2 offers in their submission to the committee:

- To set a charitable fund that residents contribute to and the proceeds from which could be used to support on-going maintenance costs.
- To play an active part in the maintenance and policing of this strip of riverbank.
