Public Safety	(a) Fire blanket and foam fire extinguisher installed as per manufacturer instructions. Gas equipment LFG GasSafe certified. Fuel for generator stored safely away from sources of ignition.
Public Order	(b) I am well-mannered & experienced in politely communicating with customers. Mobile phone within van to call Police if public order matters witnessed. CCTV in vehicle, recording. Food prepared for quick service reducing any customer build-up Location of vehicle not near pubs or nightclubs
The avoidance of public nuisance	(c) Vehicle will be powered by a Modern Honda quiet generator. Further option of enclosing generator in 20mm marine plywood internally insulated with 50mm rockwool. Quiet extraction unit within van to remove and filter odour. Customers served quickly to prevent customer build-up.

Appearance of the stall or vehicle	(d) Existing vehicle is approx 15ft long x 7.3ft wide, purpose built. Though the size is similar to other mobile traders, if either OCC or Highways are not happy with the size, I can change it for a smaller one. I can confirm the existing vehicle is in good condition, and will have professional sign-writing. The name of the vehicle, design of writing, and vehicle colour to be agreed with Oxford City Council if consent is given as I wish to maintain Oxford's appealing visual amenity.
Needs of the area	(e) Oxford High Street has a high footfall at all hours especially from people travelling to and from St. Clements, Cowley Road and Iffley Road. In addition there are large numbers of students residing nearby including those attending St Edmunds Hall, Magdalen College and Merton College. It is recognised that numerous people will be conscious of what they eat and may want healthy and/or vegetarian choices. As such one aim is to provide alternatives to the foods sold by other High Street mobile traders. The menu was considered on the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide foods reduced in saturated fat and sugar • Provide foods containing reduced salt • Reduced fizzy drinks, and provide fruit juice, vegetable juice, smoothies and bottled water Please see attached draft menu for details

Careful consideration has been given to possible concerns of the Council, Police and Highways. For example, the location of the vehicle has been chosen so that:

- a) It is not located near any nightclub or pub to avoid causing dispersal problems;
- b) The location is not a crime hot spot for relevant crimes i.e. antisocial behaviour, violence etc. This was checked via the Police Crime Map;
- c) The pavement is 15.5 foot in width resulting in no obstructions being caused when customers are waiting for food;
- d) The road is wide so a parked vehicle will not cause any obstruction for passing traffic. In addition the location is currently a single yellow line allowing parking from 18.30hrs to 06.00hrs.

I believe I would benefit the Oxford community including visitors and students, by making available a variety of nice food choices which includes healthy options, and caters for vegetarians. I would really be grateful for the opportunity to operate a new evening business from Oxford High Street.

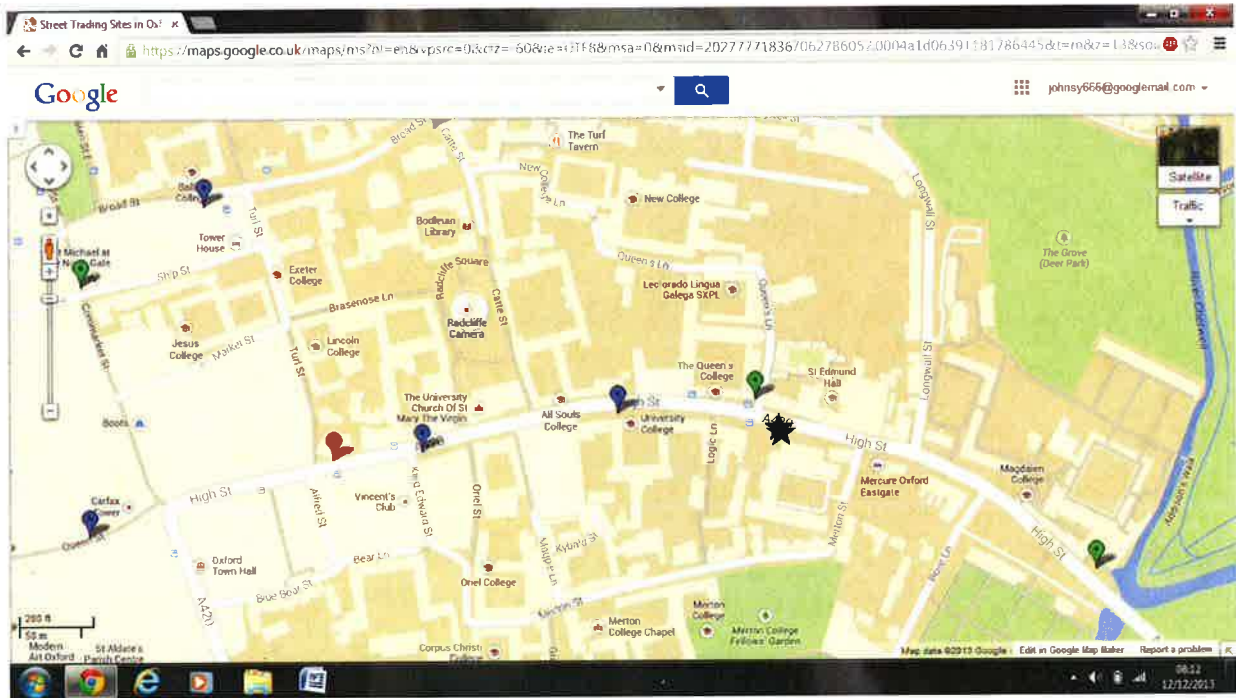
