I suffer from irricitable bowel syndrome and also Ulcerative - clitis. This means I have very little warning of any bowel movements and I therefore need to be fairly near a toilet whenever I leave my home. I, as do many others like me, need tolets. Shashgeically placed around the city ~ infact wherever I go ~ I have to make sure that this is the case, otherwise I go ~ cannot leave my home, I become happed as are many disabled a people - brough even a wheel chair, would not be an answer of the cape.

If I have an accidental Bowel movement, I wild it not catch a by home, and probably would not be allowed in a taxi, the humination and embaurossment would just be too augul to contemplate - as would having to walk home. It is also huminating to have to stand before you now to explain my predicament, but I have come to the conclusion that unless of I do nobody is ever really going to understand just how in injury it is for people like me not to have access to a public is

to let, whenever it is necessary.

I am sore, that all of the public toilets around the city (including the one in St. Giles!) were built original because there was an absolute need for them; and that need has not changed. Infear that once they are written off by the Council then they will never be open on replaced around.

Hen they will never be open or replaced again.

I know the idea of the Council is that the shops and so pulse should open their bilets for the public Mort let me assure you from my own experience, there are already greves in touch in stores—we not only need them, but all the public boilets aswell! When this idea was first floated last year Birtish tome Stores, who had until then always had their boilets open to the public; MAN once heaving of the idea they made it a rule that the public first had to prichase pay for something before

being given the code number to open the tolet door - in my case, and with my medical condition I would not have enough warning or time to first purchase an item, queue at the check out desk to pay and then given for the boilet - it would take for too long.

Also what happens after the shops have closed? Do we have to use toilets in bars and night-clubs, ploughing our way thro

a load of possibly drunken people !!

Surely if anything, public tollets are a very basic human right of any civilized society?

It is not just people with a medical complaint like nine who would suffer y any toilet is closed. "Children who are being softy-trained cannot hold on until they get to the other side the city, menshating young women; the elderly, or men and women Suffering from Crones disease; pregnant women, and wades of other people with all sorts of other bladder and bowel problems need a wilet nearby if they are going to be able to move feely

about the city It is all very well planning plush to lets for the tourists in Glouster green but surely the we the citizens and tax payers I the city, who him work, and play here see should have public amenities and our needs answered first? I personally don't care if the toolets are not particularly plush or even if people Sulleving diving addictions are using them to sleep in the most important thing to me is not to be left publicly embarrassed through not having a boilet nearby to use when I need one. I also would not mind paying 20p for the use of one provided I could get into it quickly. Even in a country as poor as Indian, they provide Atolets - even it was just a hole in the ground with a ladle and a bucket full of water to fush token, it is acceptable and prevents one from an accident and public humiliation!
