What decision was made?	To enter into a tripartite agreement with Cowley Baldon Green Limited and Thames Water Utilities Limited for the grant of an easement over land and ancillary surrender of part of an existing lease. The terms of the agreement are set out in Appendix 1 of the report to the Deputy Leader (Statutory) – Finance and Asset Management dated 4 August 2023 (exempt from publication as it contains commercially sensitive information).			
Purpose:	The decision allows the Council to enter into a contract which will result in land leased to Thames Water being surrendered back to the Council and the Council then being obliged to grant an easement to Cowley Baldon Green Limited.			
Reasons:	Oxford City Council has been approached by a developer (Cowley Baldon Green Limited) which is proposing to develop a solar farm on and adjacent to the southern boundary of the Council's land leased by Thames Water (TW). The developer cannot proceed without securing an easement from the Council to lay			

	services under the land currently leased to TW.
