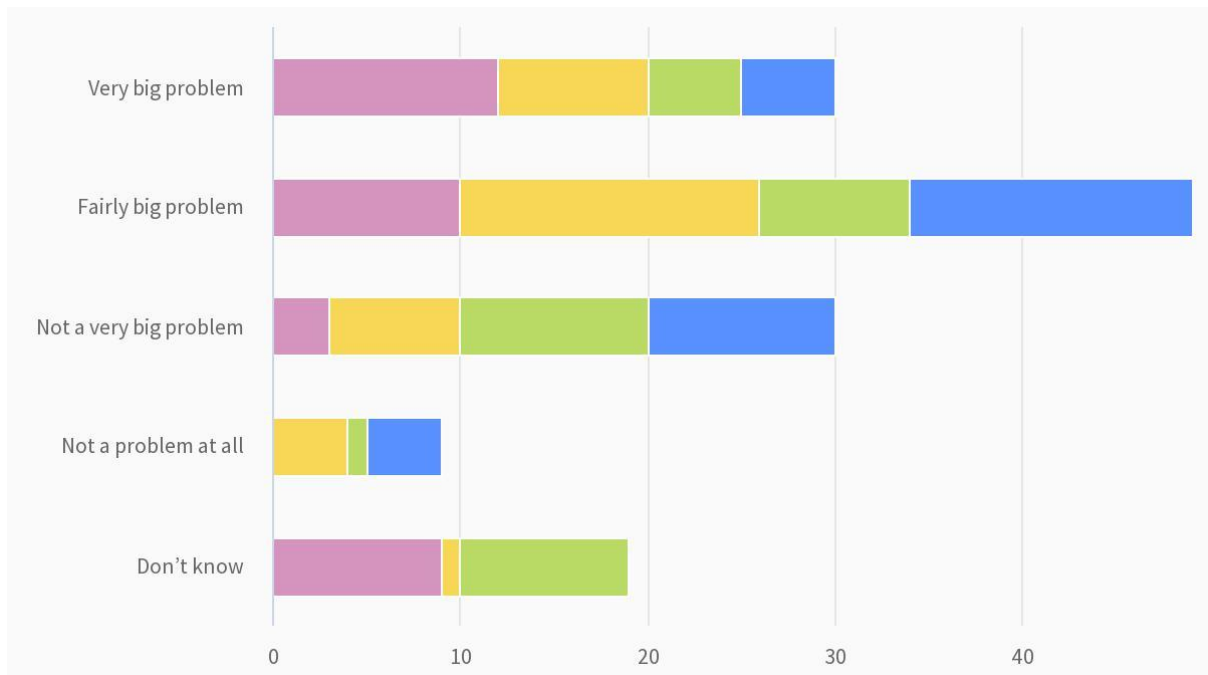

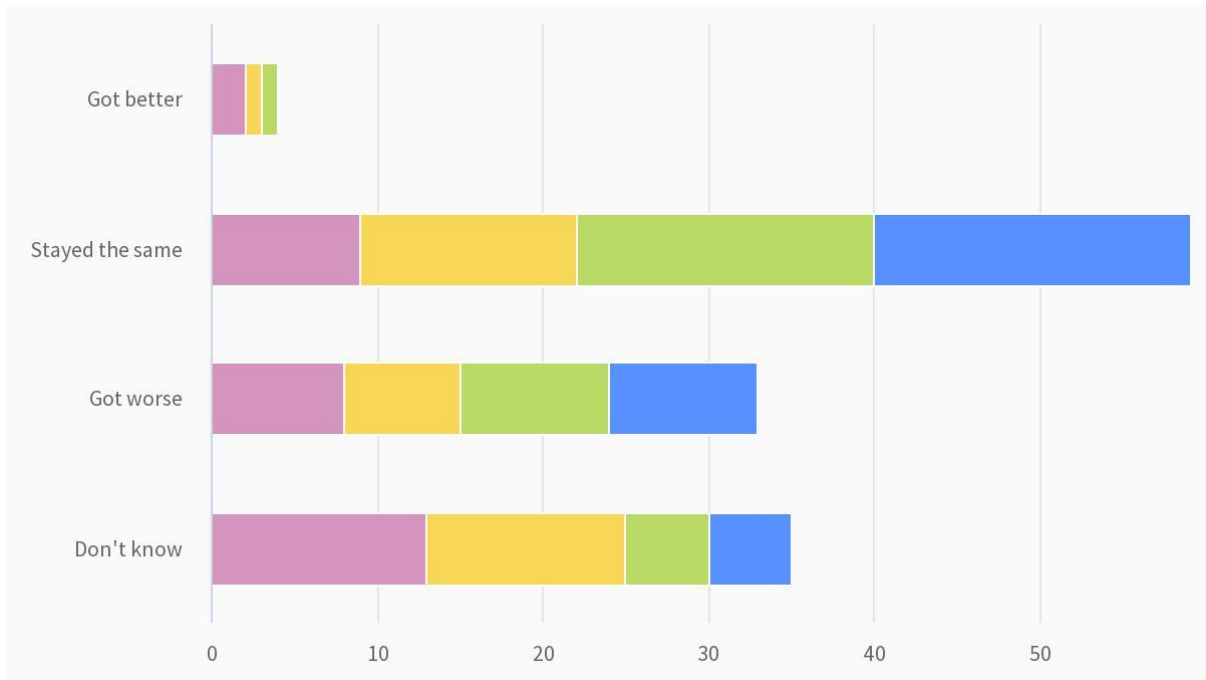

  - during the day in your neighbourhood (Blue)

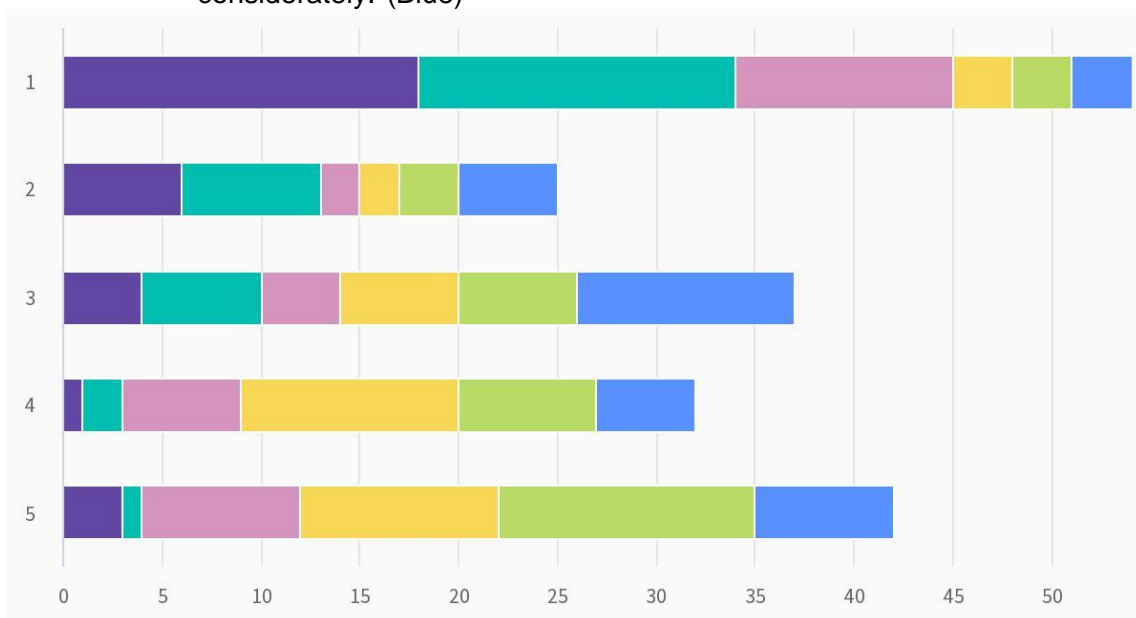


- 2) Has alcohol-related disorder got better, stayed the same or got worse over the last 12 months?

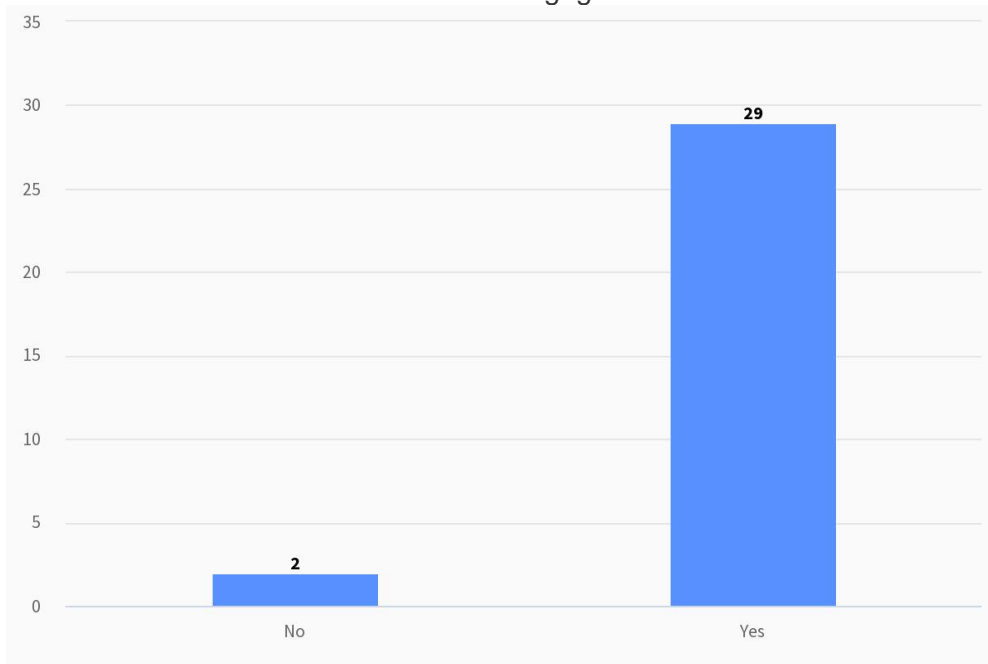
