Source of delegation:	This decision was delegated to officers under Part 4.4 of the Council's Constitution: All executive functions except the ones in Part 4.5, 4.6 and 4.7 are delegated to the officers in the senior management structure.	
What decision was made?	To allocate up to £54,980 for the installation of additional cycle racks in seven carriageway locations in Oxford. This includes the application fee for a Traffic Regulation Order and technical plans costs. A further £372.75 has been allocated for the removal of four cycle pumps that are beyond economical repair. All funds are drawn from the 2024-25 budget of the Cycling Infrastructure Fund, a Community Infrastructure Levy pot designated by the Council for cycling improvements in Oxford.	
Purpose:	This decision enables the installation of 75 cycle racks providing 150 additional cycle parking spaces in seven locations in Oxford.	
Reasons:	This decision responds to the shortage of cycle parking in Oxford and supports additional measures to encourage cycling as a means of healthy, non-polluting, active transport.

Other options considered:	No increase in cycle racks – rejected as there are areas that are currently over capacity, with some cycles being left in unsuitable/obstructive positions, and that cycling is anticipated to increase with the wider "core transport schemes" such as the upcoming traffic filters.
