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Introduction

The Infrastructure Funding Statement (IFS) is a report which sets out the amount of developer contributions from the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) and Section 106 Agreements (S106) have been <u>received</u>, <u>allocated and spent</u> on the infrastructure priorities of Oxford City Council for the previous financial year (April 2023 - March 2024). In accordance with the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations, any authority that receives a contribution from development through the Levy or Section 106 planning obligations must prepare an Infrastructure Funding Statement. (CIL PPG paragraph 173 Reference ID: 25-173-20190901).¹

This IFS is prepared in accordance with Schedule 2 of the CIL regulations² and CIL regulation 121A. Developer contributions were previously monitored on the AMR, but now are recorded separately in the IFS.

Funding for infrastructure on the IFS has been considered and updated alongside the Infrastructure Delivery Plan (Infrastructure Assessment). This is a live document which is currently being updated on an ongoing basis to inform future funding priorities.³ (CIL PPG paragraph 17, Reference ID: 25-017-20190901).

3: Infrastructure projects to be funded wholly or partly by CIL

The current CIL held has been committed in full to projects/schemes within the Council's Capital Programme as part of the Budget setting process. CIL is used alongside other funding sources to deliver projects and schemes across the city as part of the Capital Programme.

The funding of projects and schemes from CIL is set annually as part of the wider budget setting process for the Capital Programme with minor budget adjustments being made throughout the year, if and when necessary. The programme below sets out how funding from CIL is to be allocated to different infrastructure projects for the reported year and upcoming 5 years - however, this is currently under review. As part of the budget setting process, which at the time of reporting has not yet completed (completion expected Feb/Mar 2025), projects and allocations may change. The following table in this section only shows the funding from CIL and does not show full scheme costs or other funding sources.
